Cross-stitch chart
(Ref. MGL001-BISC)

INSTRUCTIONS

Size of the chart (when using the recommended fabric):

70 x 70 stitches (for each side of the biscornu)

Approximately: 11 x 11 cm (x2)

Recommended fabric:

type: 32ct Zweigart Belfast Linen

colour: antique white (101)

For the finishing touches, you will also need:

- some polyester filling or some Granulex Soft stuffing granules
- 2 pearlescent buttons for the finishing touches.

Other instructions:

- Linen should be worked over **2 threads of fabric**, unless otherwise stated.
- All stitches should be worked using **2 strands of cotton**, unless otherwise stated.
- The **small arrows** on the chart point to the centre of the design.
- When a chart spreads over more than 1 page, the **grey shaded areas** show the **overlap**.
- When **speciality stitches** are used, please feel free to refer to the stitch tutorial at the end of the booklet.

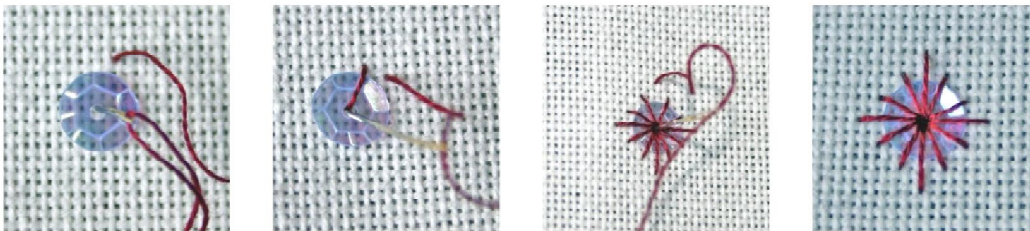
Stitch tutorial

Queen Stitch:



Start with a long upright stitch in the middle of your Queen stitch. Bring your needle out again halfway across the height of this stitch and tack it in place. Then, bring your needle out in the same hole as you used for the first stitch, and repeat the process to the right. Then work on the left side of your Queen stitch. Don't over tighten the vertical stitches so that the finished effect is that of supple lines.

Diamond Eyelet stitch (with sequin):



Start with a diagonal line (rather than vertical), and work clockwise from the outside of the diamond shape towards the inside (because of the sequin, it's easier to fit your needle through the middle from the front of your work than from the back).



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
