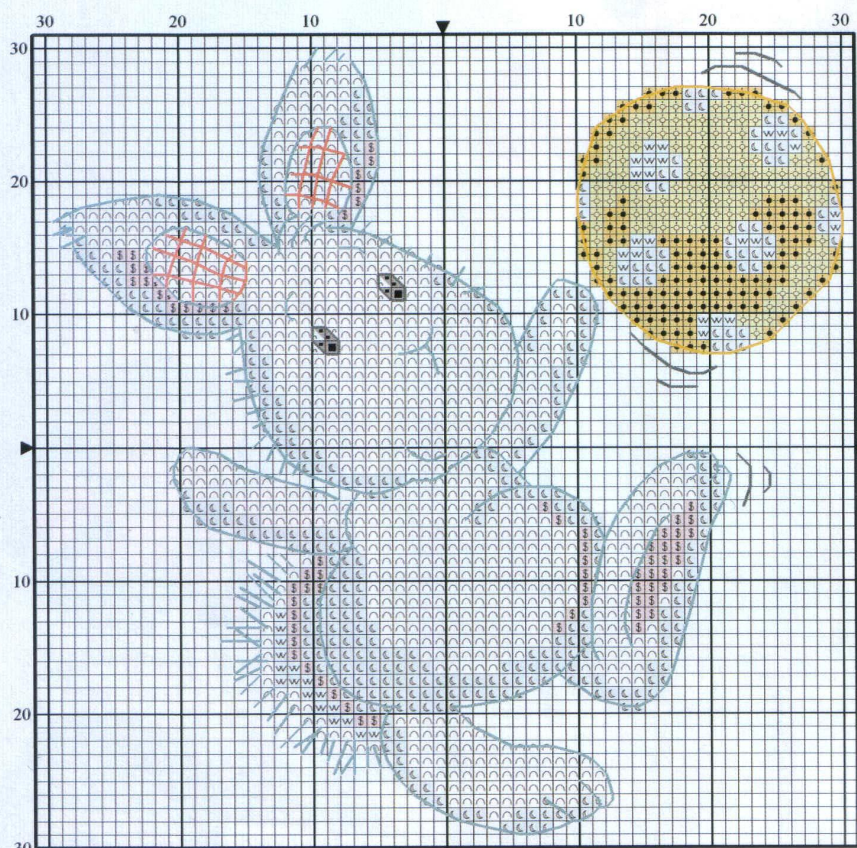

Bun Bun chart



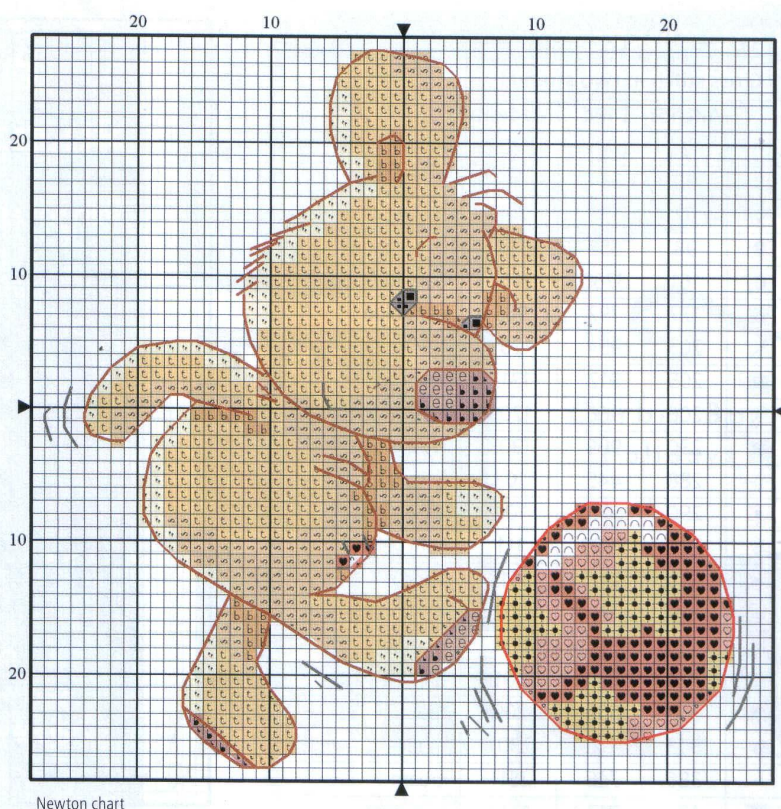
Reader panel

Leave off the buttons if you are stitching for a child under three to keep your cushion safer for little ones





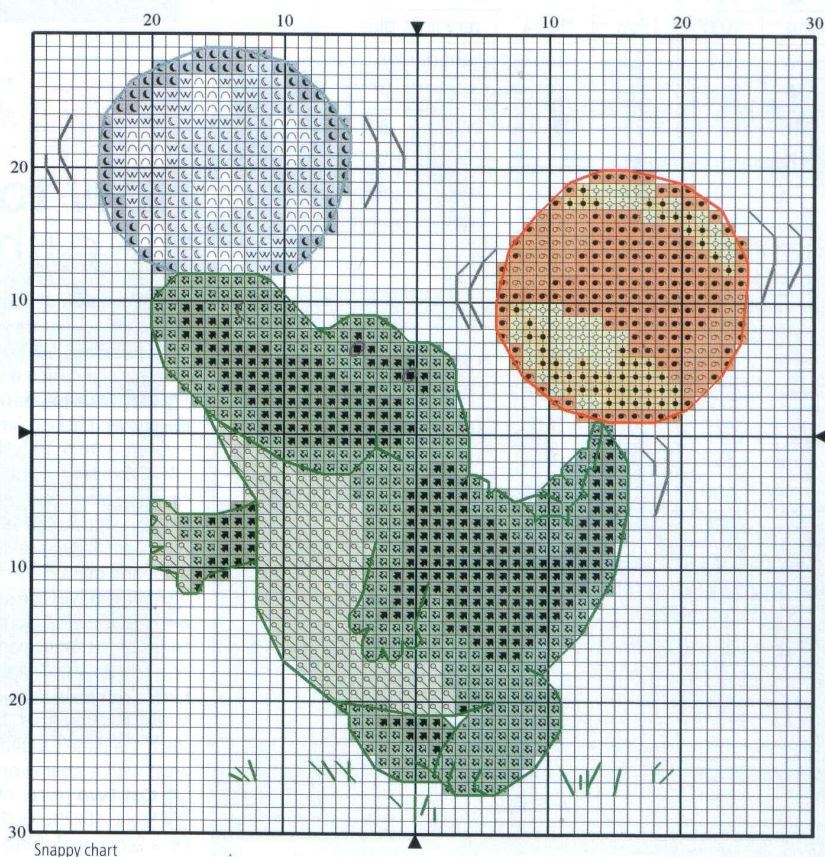

- ✕ A piece of 14-count white aida measuring 20x20cm (8x8in) for each design
- ✕ Stranded cotton listed in the key
- ✕ Size 24 tapestry needle
- ✕ Fabric of your choice for cushion
- ✕ Cushion pad

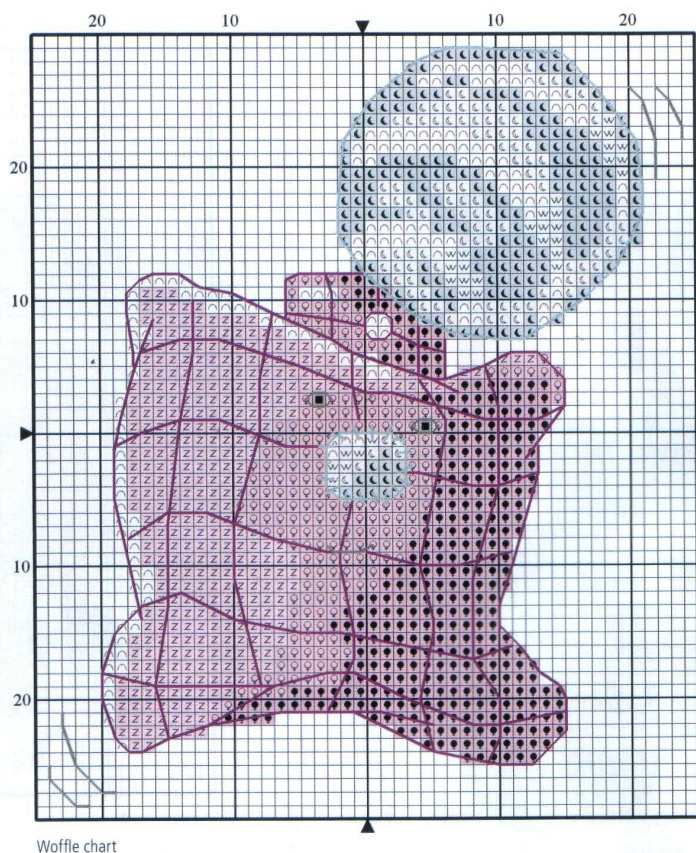

How to make the cushion

1 Trim each of your stitched panels so that they measure 16.5x16.5cm (6½x6½in), making sure that the design is central.

2 Cut four pieces of your chosen backing fabric measuring 16.5x16.5cm (6½x6½in) for the front panels. Pin these along each edge of the Newton stitched panel using a 2cm seam allowance. Machine stitch and press.

3 Pin each of the stitched corner panels along two edges of the fabric panel with a 2cm seam allowance so that they form a complete square shape for the cushion front. Machine stitch the panels together and press with a steam iron.

4 Cut two pieces of backing fabric 40x28cms (15½x11in). Pin a 2cm double hem along one long edge of each piece of fabric. Machine-stitch and press with a steam iron.

5 With the right sides facing, pin the long raw edge of one panel to the top edge of the assembled cushion front. Pin the sides of the panel down each side of the cushion front with a 2cm seam. Machine stitch in place with a 2cm seam.

6 Take your second backing panel and pin the long raw edge to the bottom of the assembled cushion front. Pin the sides of the panel down each side of the cushion front with a 2cm seam. Machine stitch together with a 2cm seam.

7 Trim the corners, then turn through to the right side and press. Hand-stitch the buttons at the four corners of the central panel if you are using, and insert cushion pad to finish.
