## Materials

- Zweigart Ice Blue 14 count aida, ref: 3706/0550; 50x50cm (19½x19½in)
  - Stranded cotton as listed in the key
  - Size 24 tapestry needle
  - Backing fabric; 39x39cm (15½x15½in)
  - Cushion pad; 35.5x35.5cm (14x14in)

This design was stitched on 14 count aida fabric.

## Make a... cushion

### Step 1

**COMPLETE** the stitching, then cut the aida to 39x39cm (15½x15½in), with the design in the centre.

### Step 2

**PLACE** the cushion front right-sides together with the backing fabric. Pin, then machine stitch, around the edge with a 1.25cm (½in) seam allowance, leaving a gap for turning.

### Step 3

**TURN** to the right side, insert the cushion pad and sew up the gap with small, neat stitches.
